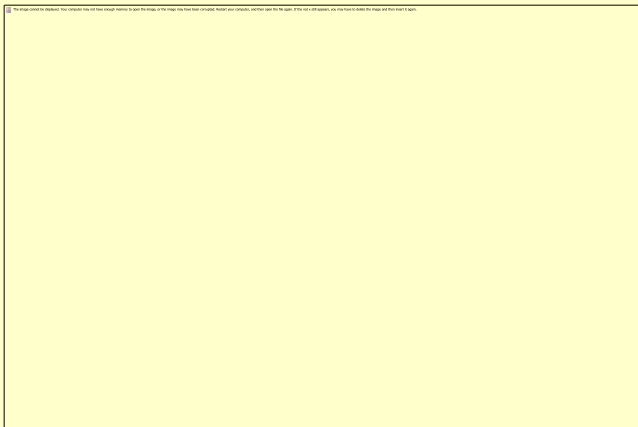
This year we considered God's perfect design in Creation and how it speaks of a HUGE God interested in little Us. We talked about how humbling it is to consider that the Creator of the

We are a character in His story.

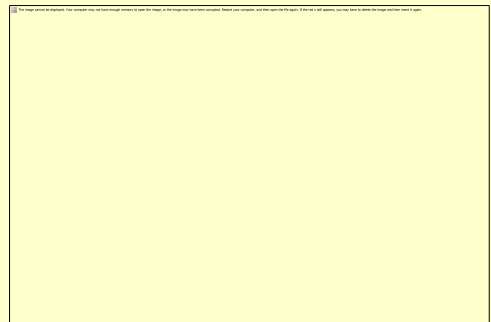

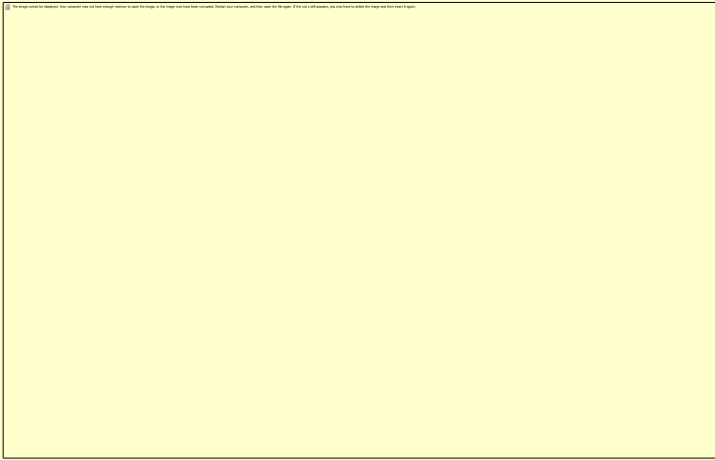
Keep praying for the miracle of Salvation to rule the hearts and lives of our kids through these camps.
