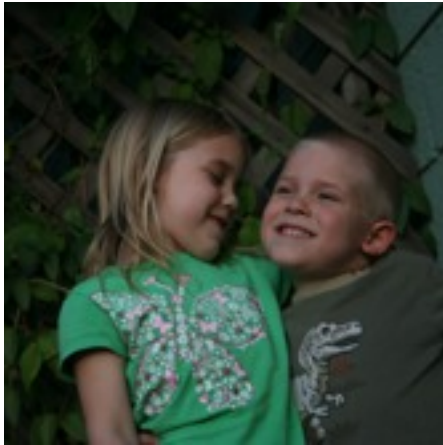

Timeline

Now the BIG move! We will be leaving for Cameroon with our first step being an orientation on how to live in Africa. After that we will begin serving in our new roles.
