

# Hebrews 1: 5-14

## True of Jesus

**:5 God calls Jesus His Son  
(Psalms 2:7) (II Samuel 7:14)**

**:6 God tells the angels to  
worship the Son  
(Psalms 97:7)**

**:8&9 But the Son sits on a  
throne. He is the One who  
made the heavens and earth  
(Psalm 45:7)**

## True of Angels

**:5 God never calls an angel  
His son**

**:6 God never tells the Son to  
worship the angels**

**:7 God makes angels into  
“winds” and “flames of fire”  
to minister to people. They  
are powerful, yes  
(Psalm 104:4)**

# Hebrews 1: 5-14

## True of Jesus

**:10 The Son is the One who made the heavens and the earth (Psalm 102:25)**

**:11&12 The earth, the Son made, will one day be gone – but the Son will remain (Psalm 102:26 & 27)**

**:13 The Son has been given the honor of sitting at the right hand of God the Father (Psalm 110:1)**

**:14 (implied) the Son provides salvation – not the angels**

## True of Angels

**:10 (implied) The angels were part of the creation of the earth. *He made them.***

**:11&12 (implied) As part of the Son's creation, the angels depend on Him for their very survival**

**:13 The angels have never been given that honor.**

**:14 The angels' job is to care for those who will come to belief in the Son.**
