The Lord continues to bless us with the honor of serving Him here in Haiti on your behalf.

Church Growth: All the churches we have started are pastored by nationals. As often as we can we visit these churches and rejoice as they report of souls being saved, baptized, and growing in the Lord. We also notice that most are growing in attendance.

Ka Jeorges Construction: As we write this letter the walls are completed at the Berean Baptist Church in Ka Jeorges. By the time you receive this the roof should be finished.

New work in 2012: We are considering the village of Ka Philippe for a new work to be established next year. Please pray for the Lord's direction in this matter.

Berean Baptist Bible School and Seminary: This month we have finished an exciting trimester of teaching the Word to nearly 500 students. We will begin a new trimester in January. Also, in January 53 Christian workers will graduate from the Bible school and seminary.

Land for Privil: Our newest church plant will be one year old in February. Please pray for land for this ministry.

2011 Hurricane Season: We praise the Lord that Haiti was spared from devastating floods during this hurricane season.

Cathy's health: Over the last few years Cathy has developed a condition called syncope which causes her to get dizzy and pass out if she gets too hot. Due to the heat and humidity here she was experiencing episodes like this from time to time. After much prayer, effort, and expense we were able to get better electricity from the city and installed an air conditioner in our bedroom/study. Since she is able to get away from the heat at times now, it has allowed her to be able to get out and be involved in the ministry and still keep this condition under control. We thank the Lord for this situation being resolved.
